BOORT BOWLS CLUB NEWS

The Boort Bowls Club held the Official Opening of their new artificial greens and the opening of the Club's 2022 - 2023 season on Sunday 18th of September.

He thanked the Shire, for without their financial assistance this project would not have been achieved.

Councillor Neil Beattie also spoke about the project and the other projects also taking place in Boort from the Shire grant. He was then followed on by the Loddon Shire Mayor, Councillor Dan Straub who also delivered an informative speech.

The Hon. Peter Walsh M.P. then concluded on behalf of the District. Peter has also got some very close ties to the Boort area, having farmed and lived in the District for a considerable time, thus knowing a lot of the Boort people.

A cutting of the ribbon to open the new green then took place with

Gillian Tweddle (Secretary) and Margaret Nelson holding the ribbon while President John did the cutting.

The commencement of the day's bowls took place after the 2021-2022 Ladies Club Champion Thelma Moresi delivered the first jack and the Men's Club Champion Shayne Morris delivered the first bowl using a set of 1912 bowls owned by Ivan Streader.

Early bird discount tickets for SPF22 will apply for registrations for the entire month of July.

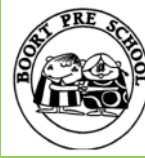

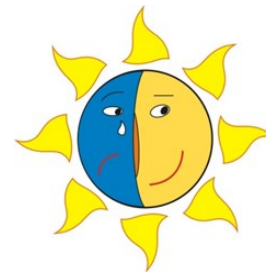

Over 6,000 Victorians suffer an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest every year. A cardiac arrest occurs when the heart suddenly stops, and immediate action is critical to save a life. For every minute without lifesaving intervention, a person's chance of surviving decreases rapidly. Tragically, only one in 10 people survive.

That is why it is vital that bystanders act quickly in the first critical moments of a cardiac arrest.

When a bystander performs cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), a person is twice as likely to survive. If an automated external defibrillator (AED) is also used, this survival rate dramatically increases from one in 10 to more than seven in 10.
