

Boort Development Committee Report

Loddon Shire and Boort Development Committee are making good progress on a number of Boort Projects at the moment, so here's a brief summary:

- The major upgrade to the Playground at Nolens Park will be finished in August. The new play equipment looks great and the colours are wonderful - the kids should really love this space now, and it will attract more families to use the Park.
- The new light poles for Federation Walk have now been delivered to Boort and they will be put up shortly. A new concrete edge will be added to the walkway and the light poles concreting will be integrated with this. The adjacent lawn areas will be lowered to be level with the paving.
- We've just been granted extra Shire funding to replace 3 of the worst old lakeside BBO's with new ones. The new BBQ's will go into Nolens Park, Rotary Park, and adjacent to the Yacht Club.

All these works will be completed in the next month or two, and well before the summer visitor season, so this is a good outcome for the town and community. We will look to arrange a projects completion celebration at Nolens Park - details to be firmed up in due course.

Boort Development Committee is again running it's 2 major sculpture events in 2016. The Sculpture Workshops at the Men's Shed kick off on 10 September, so if you would like to get involved, or if you have scrap metal to donate, just contact a Committee member or email: boortdev@hotmail.com. The Sculpture Competition will once again be a highlight of the Boort Show, with \$4,000 of prize money on offer! Go to: www.boortsculp.wordpress.com for full details and the entry form.




