A few weeks ago, she returned to Boort with family and spent some hours in the Historical Society with Boort members relating her stories and other memories from her early years whilst living at Barraport with her family.

Her dad was James Haveckin and mum was Jessie (nee Seymour). They lived on a property called "Kinora" which is where James worked. Sabina attended the Barraport school. One story she told about the school building, was that it was often shifted nearest to the family with the most children.

The family left Boort when Sabina was 15 years old. Her brother Thomas served in WWII and his name appears on the Boort Honour Board. She was able to provide a photo of him in uniform for a book we have published about all the Service Men and Women who enlisted from Boort.
