Sepsis Awareness Day at BDH

Tuesday 16.09.2025 we came together at Boort District Health to shine a light on sepsis – a condition that can affect anyone, anytime.

A heartfelt thank you to our community members, staff, families, Safer Care Victoria delegates, representatives from our board of directors and our friends from nearby organisations who joined us.

The day featured informative talks from health professionals and an interactive quiz session that got everyone thinking about recognising the signs of sepsis and acting fast.



What Boort District Health Team Do

- **Early recognition:**
 - Boort District Health nurses are trained to identify sepsis signs quickly in acute ward, Urgent Care Centre (UCC), and aged care using sepsis pathway and point of care testing.
- **Rapid response:**
 - We use evidence-based sepsis pathways to start urgent treatment, including IV fluids, antibiotics, and monitoring.
- **Referral & transfer:**
 - When higher-level care is needed, we coordinate with Ambulance Victoria and regional hospitals for safe and timely transfer.
- **Education & prevention:**
 - We promote vaccination (flu, pneumonia, COVID-19), hand hygiene, and wound care to reduce infection risks.
- **Recovery support:**
 - Staff provide follow-up advice, wellbeing checks, and link patients to community health services after a sepsis episode.

Discovery Centre Incurion F - 6:


