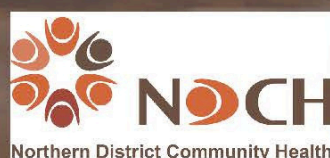

Born on 20th May 1926 at Boort Hospital, Peggy's (Margaret Mitchell) life has been filled with resilience, love, and remarkable stories.



Peg's mother Ada travelled from England and met Peg's father Jack, a shipbuilder, during WWI in France – the beginning of a strong family legacy.

Growing up, Peg enjoyed a true country childhood – riding bikes, helping on the farm, and travelling by horse and gig to Mysia School. During WWII, she stepped in to help her father on the farm while her brother was away at war, showing strength and dedication from a young age.

Peggy later married Howard in the Presbyterian church, beginning a new chapter on their farm at Barrakee. Together they raised their children, Pam and Peter, building a life centred on family, hard work, and community. Whether feeding shearers, baking, or enjoying a game of tennis (her favourite!), Peg embraced every moment.

She has always appreciated the simple joys of life – especially a classic roast lamb dinner with all the trimmings – and a good book, later switching to audiobooks to continue her love of reading.

Peg's quiet strength, warmth, and independence have been an inspiration to all who know her. From early farm days to a life rich in family, community, and cherished memories, she truly represents a century well lived.

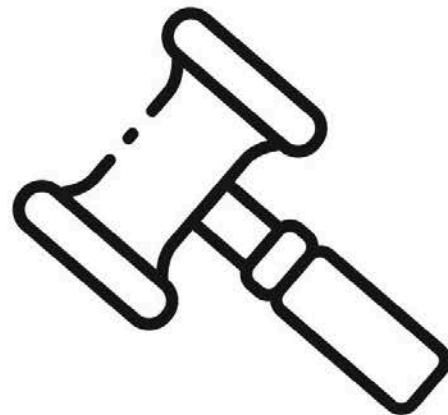

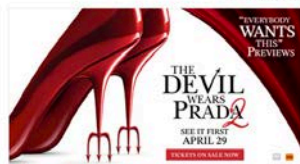
