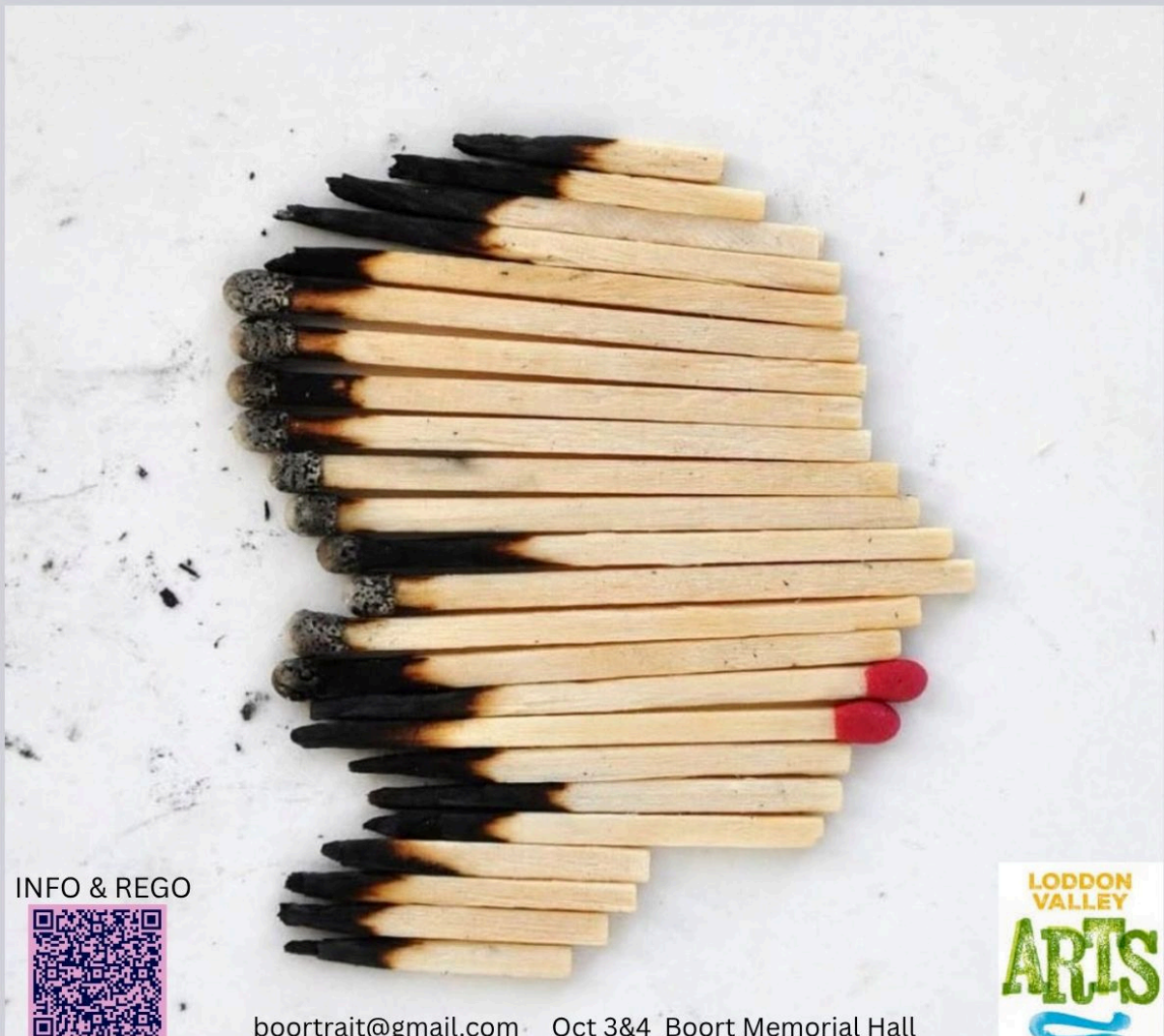

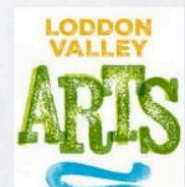

Well done to everyone involved!

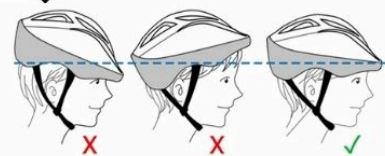


Bike/Scooter Education
